About Us

Peking University (PKU) is located in the scenic northwestern district of Beijing, the capital of the People's Republic of China. The first modern national university established in China, it was founded during the late Qing Dynasty in 1898 as the Imperial University of Peking. Throughout its history, PKU has played an important role at the center of major intellectual and progressive movements in modern Chinese history.

As a top-ranked global university, PKU provides unique opportunity for learning with its diverse branches in natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, business and management, information and engineering sciences, and health sciences, and its interdisciplinary academic programs. The university consists of 30 colleges and 12 independent departments, with 93 undergraduate, 199 Master's degree and 173 doctoral programs.



PKU Health Science Center, also known as PKU Medicine, comprises of the schools of basic medical sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, clinical medicine, dental medicine, public health and nursing, with 10 affiliated hospitals and medical centers.

The Executive MPH Program is offered by the PKU School of Public Health, with its 150 multi-disciplinary faculty from the departments of biostatistics, epidemiology, health policy and management, occupational and environmental health, maternal and child health, nutrition and food safety, health education and behavioral sciences, global health, toxicology, and public health laboratory sciences.

Program Details

We aim to train talents in the field of public health with a vision to lead health development across the globe.

Admission Requirements

Peking University Executive MPH Program annually enrolls approximately 30 new students from both China and abroad. International students comprise roughly 90% of the student body.

Applicants should have:

- Two-year working experience in health-related fields;
- Undergraduate degree or first degree from an accredited college or university;
- English proficiency;
- Leadership potential.



Program Organization

The duration of the course is 2 years, completing a required 45 credit hours:

- 1st year full-time study at Peking University
- 2nd year practicum/internship/fieldwork in home country
- Capstone thesis

Tuition, Fees, and Scholarships

The total tuition fee is ¥150,000. Peking University is committed to enrolling a talented and diverse student body with representation from all countries and regions. Scholarships may be available through the Chinese Scholarship Council.
